

Customer Cross Connection Survey

Butler County Rural Water District No. 3 Board of Directors is aware of the possible dangers of cross connections and has adopted a policy on cross connection control to comply with Kansas regulations. The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is requiring our District to update our cross connection control program and have our customers complete surveys for our entire system. A plumbing cross connection is an actual or potential connection between a public water supply and a source of contamination or pollution (liquid, solid or gas). When a cross connection exists, it is possible for a contaminant to enter the drinking water system when the pressure of the polluted source exceeds the pressure of the potable (drinkable) source that may result in a backsiphonage or backflow. The enclosed brochure *Let's Work Together for Safe Water* provides additional information. **Every RWD #3 customer has a civic duty and responsibility to help safeguard your own system and the Rural Water District from cross connections and contamination.**
